Due to an article in the Cape Gazette, there has been a lot of discussion around town about the possibility of a drug rehabilitation center opening in Spartan Station. The statement in the article that the project has been approved is misleading. As far as the City of Harrington is concerned, the project is in the beginning stages. The City staff has met one time with the Connections staff to discuss zoning and the development process. This use may be permitted in this zone. No paperwork has been officially submitted. The approvals are from the State; Governor Markell wants to have a drug rehabilitation center in lower Kent or upper Sussex County. No City approvals have been applied for or granted.

In other news, the City is currently advertising for bids on the inflow and infiltration work and the Dorman Street sewer project. Work will be starting soon on those projects.
