**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A DELAWARE LAND AND WATER
CONSERVATION TRUST FUND GRANT APPLICATION TO FUND
IMPROVEMENTS TO FREEDOM PARK**

WHEREAS, the City of Harrington intends to improve Freedom Park with landscaping, sidewalks, and signage; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to request twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) from the Delaware Land and Water Conservation Trust Fund (DTF) Grant Program; and


WHEREAS, the City has met the DTF 50% match requirement for said request by means of funds from donations and various seized money; and

WHEREAS, the City assigns Police Chief Norman Barlow to manage the project and coordinate the DTF Program requirements for reporting and reimbursements;

WHEREAS, the City understands that parkland acquired or improved with DTF funding assistance will remain available to the public for outdoor recreation in perpetuity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council agrees that the City, if selected for DTF Grant funds, shall abide by the requirements of the DTF Grant Program for reimbursements and stewardship responsibilities; and

THEREFORE, BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution was passed by a majority of the City Council of Harrington on this 15th day of July 2013.
