ORDINANCE NO. 14-02

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 365, STREETS AND SIDEWALKS,
OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF HARRINGTON TO AMEND THE TIME
ALLOWED FOR REMOVAL OF SNOW FROM SIDEWALKS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
HARRINGTON IN COUNCIL MET:


Section 1. That § 365-28 shall be amended by deleting the existing section and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

It shall be unlawful for the owner or occupant of any premises abutting upon a sidewalk to permit or allow snow or ice to remain thereon for longer than twenty-four (24) hours after it has ceased snowing or the ice forming, or to permit debris or other materials to accumulate at any time so that pedestrians may not conveniently and safely pass. At the discretion of the City Manager, and/or his/her designee, the time allowed to remove snow and ice from sidewalks may be extended because of extremely cold temperatures.

Repealer. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Effective Date. The Clerk of Council shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law; and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by Council.

SO ORDAINED by the majority of Council Members present at a regular session of Harrington City Council, to be effective upon signing.

SYNOPSIS

This Ordinance amends Chapter 365, Streets and Sidewalks, to change the time allowed for property owners or occupants to remove snow and ice from sidewalks from 12 hours of daylight to 24 hours after it has ceased snowing or the ice has formed. It also allows for an extension of that time for extremely cold temperatures.
