

## **CITY OF HARRINGTON COMPREHENSIVE REZONE**

The City of Harrington adopted the Comprehensive Land Use Plan in 2014. Public Hearings were held to determine the future land use for parcels of land within the City limits. State law requires that municipalities comprehensively adopt zoning to match the certified Comprehensive Land Use Plan Future Land Use Map within 18 months of certification. The City of Harrington is currently conducting a comprehensive rezoning; the property owners of parcels with proposed zoning changes have been notified by certified mail.

A map and list of the parcels proposed to be rezoned are available on the City website, <http://harrington.delaware.gov>, and in City Hall, 106 Dorman St. The proposed Zoning Code is available on the City's website, in City Hall, and in the Harrington Public Library, 110 E. Center St.

The City Council will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, July 20, 2015 at 7:00 pm at Harrington City Hall, 106 Dorman St., Harrington, DE 19952 prior to the second reading and possible adoption of the proposed Zoning Map, which includes the proposed zoning changes.
