

**CITY OF HARRINGTON
ORDINANCE NO. 14-12**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 212, FLOODPLAIN REGULATIONS,
OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF HARRINGTON TO ADOPT A NEW
DEFINITION OF HISTORIC STRUCTURE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
HARRINGTON IN COUNCIL MET:

Section 1. That § 212-9 shall be amended by deleting the existing
definition for Historic Structure and substituting in lieu thereof the following:


Historic Structure: Any structure that is:

- (1) Individually listed in the National Register of Historic Places (a listing maintained by the U.S. Department of Interior) or preliminarily determined by the Secretary of the Interior as meeting the requirements for individual listing on the National Register; or
- (2) Certified or preliminarily determined by the Secretary of the Interior as contributing to the historical significance of a registered historic district or a district preliminarily determined by the Secretary to qualify as a registered historic district.

Repealer. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Effective Date. The Clerk of Council shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law; and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by Council.

SO ORDAINED by the majority of Council Members present at a regular session of Harrington City Council, to be effective upon signing.
