
RESOLUTION 16-R-03

WHEREAS, at a poll held on September 15, 2015, voters in the City of Harrington expressed support for the imposition of term limits on elected officials in the City of Harrington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Harrington requests that the General Assembly amend Section 5.2.3 of the City Charter to provide as follows:

5.2.3. Limitation in Terms. No person shall serve as Mayor for more than two (2) consecutive terms. No person shall serve as a member of Council for more than three (3) consecutive terms. If no eligible candidate files a petition for the office of a term-limited incumbent within the time prescribed by this Charter, the incumbent may remain in office for another term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution was adopted by a majority of the City Council of Harrington on this 22nd day of February 2016.
