UTILITY BILLS DUE

AUGUST 10TH, 2025

UTILITY DISCONNECT FOR NON-PAYMENT

Effective July 1, 2021, any delinquent utility account not paid by the end of business on the day prior to disconnect day will be assessed a \$50 service fee. To have services restored a \$50 service fee will be assessed during normal business hours and a \$150 service fee will be assessed for after hours.

- All vehicles must be properly tagged and registered.
- Outdoor burning is prohibited unless in an approved receptacle.

A MESSAGE FROM FRANK TOLSON

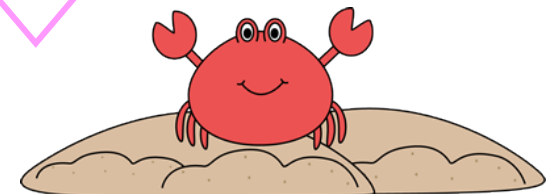
Happy Summer City of Harrington!
